




Good success rate of PT applications (27%)

Evolution in focus


2014-2020

Future projects

Evolution of the main features (more flexibility)

- 'Lighter' focus on Structural Funds programmes
 (only 1 policy instrument per project must be a SF programmes)
- More flexibility in the phases1 core phase & 1 follow-up phase
- Action plans depending on core phase results
- Pilot actions possible from the start
