Topics explored - Decisions taken**

13:00 – 13:15 Registration and welcome coffee

13:15 – 13:25 Welcome by Arvo Sarapuu, Deputy Mayor of Tallinn

13:25 – 13:40 INTHERWASTE project overview, Liis Rääk, Tallinn Environment Department

Liis Rääk introduced the objectives and activities of INTHERWASTE project and spoke about the best practices in Cordoba (partners meeting on April).

13:40 – 14:10 History of Tallinn waste management, Jüri Kuuskemaa, Tallinn City Office

Mr Jüri Kuuskemaa is one of the most famous historian in Estonia. He spoke how was waste management in Tallinn Old Town organized since the 13th century.

14:10 – 14:30 Current situation and trends of waste management in Tallinn, Kristjan Mark, Tallinn Environment Department

Kristjan Mark spoke about current situation and waste collection schemes in Tallinn – door-to-door collection, recycling stations and collection points. Also pointed out current capture rates and statistics.

14:30 – 14:45 Waste Management in Estonia, Peeter Eek, Ministry of the Environment (not planned in schedule)

Peeter Eek is Head of the Waste Division of Ministry of the Environment. His presentation was not planned in the schedule but audience gave him the word. Peeter spoke about waste management and statistics across the country.

14:45 – 14:55 Heritage conservation restrictions related to waste management in Tallinn Old Town, Boris Dubovik, Tallinn Urban Planning Department

Mr Dubovik is Head of the Culture Heritage Protection Division. He talked about restrictions in Tallinn Old Town and gave some examples about the complexity of construction activity.

14:55 – 14:15 Tallinn Waste Center activities, Kertu Tiitso, Head of Tallinn Waste Center

Mrs Tiitso outlined activities of Tallinn Waste Center and talked about practical problems and solutions on waste collection.

Questions & Answers

Representatives of Apartment Associations and Tallinn Old Town Associations asked questions and highlighted some problems in Tallinn Old Town - access complexity, lack of packaging waste containers etc.

Suggestions on topics for next meetings: location for the containers, separate collection, control and supervision on private companies offering waste disposal services in the Old Town, door to door collection (with certain timetable), implementation of shared containers, public events in the Old Town (waste reduction etc)

Most participants agreed to participate also in next meeting and in stakeholders groups.
