Galera is ubicated far away from large population centers, equidistant between the cities of Murcia and Granada (150 Kms).














Galera has more than 50 archaeological catalogued sites.

1. THE MUSEUM OF GALERA

- 2001: Opened to the public.
- Galera's heritage is assembled around this museum.
- There we'll find archaeologic and ethnographic sections.
- It preserves and exhibits the mummified remains of the grave 121 of the site of Castellón, 4,000 years old.





2. TÚTUGI NECROPOLIS

- First dig was made in 1918.
- Construction began in the 5th century BC.
- It contains more than 130 family graves.
- In the grave 20 appeared the Goddess of Galera.
- It opens to the public in 2007.




