Lowkey assessment tool (self – assessment)

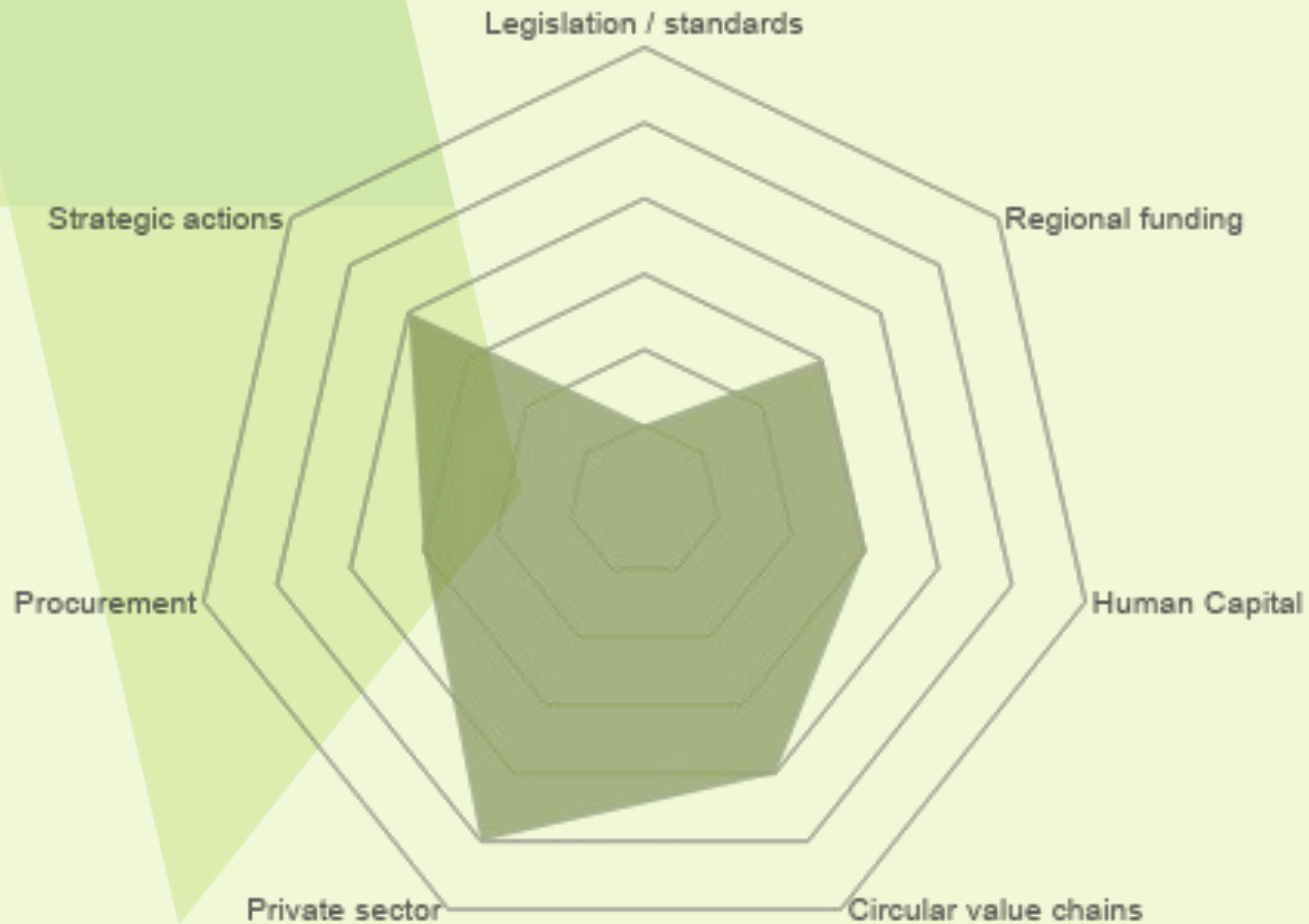

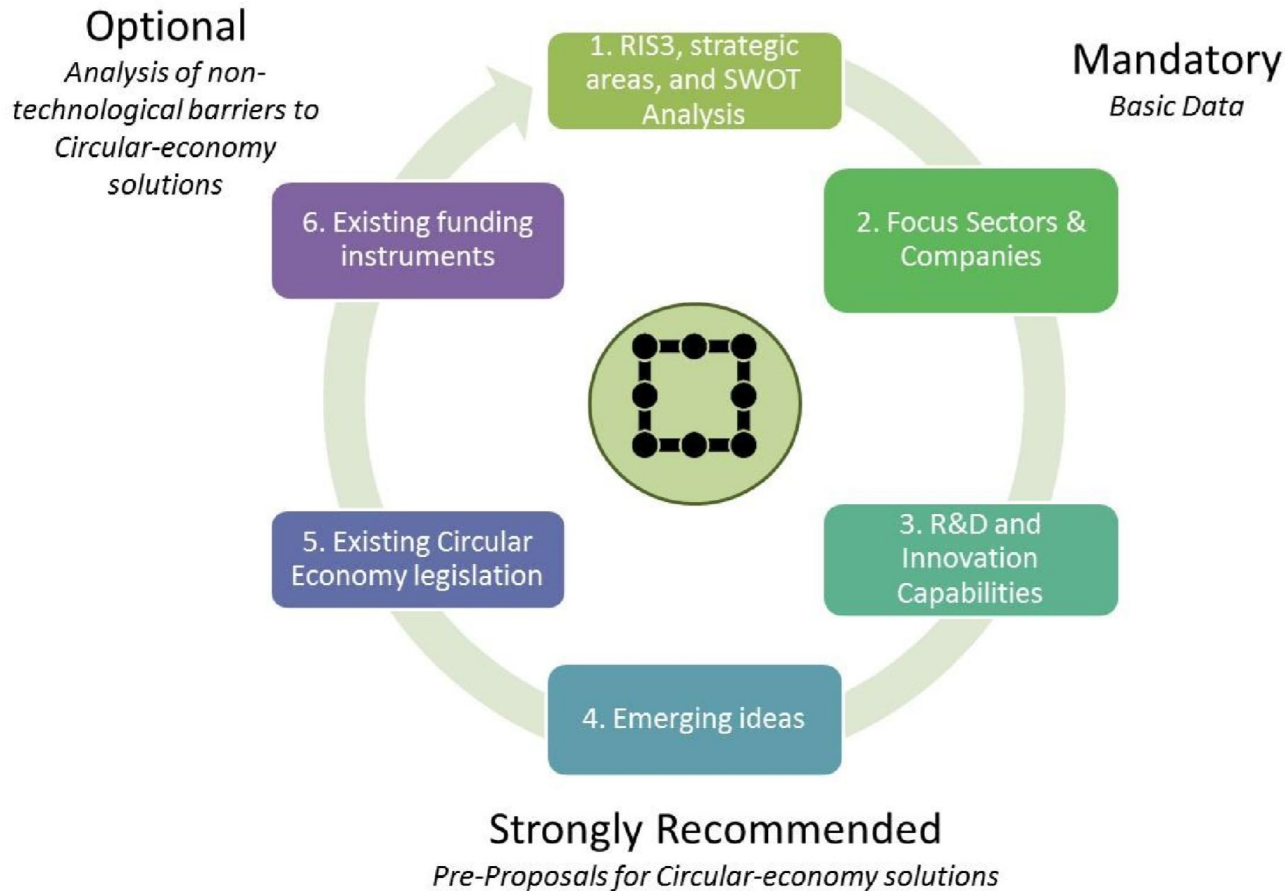


Figure 1: the SCREEN mapping Framework



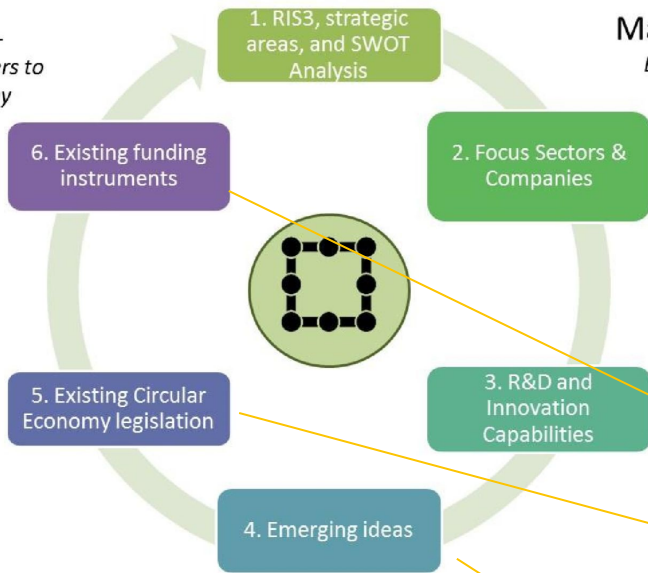

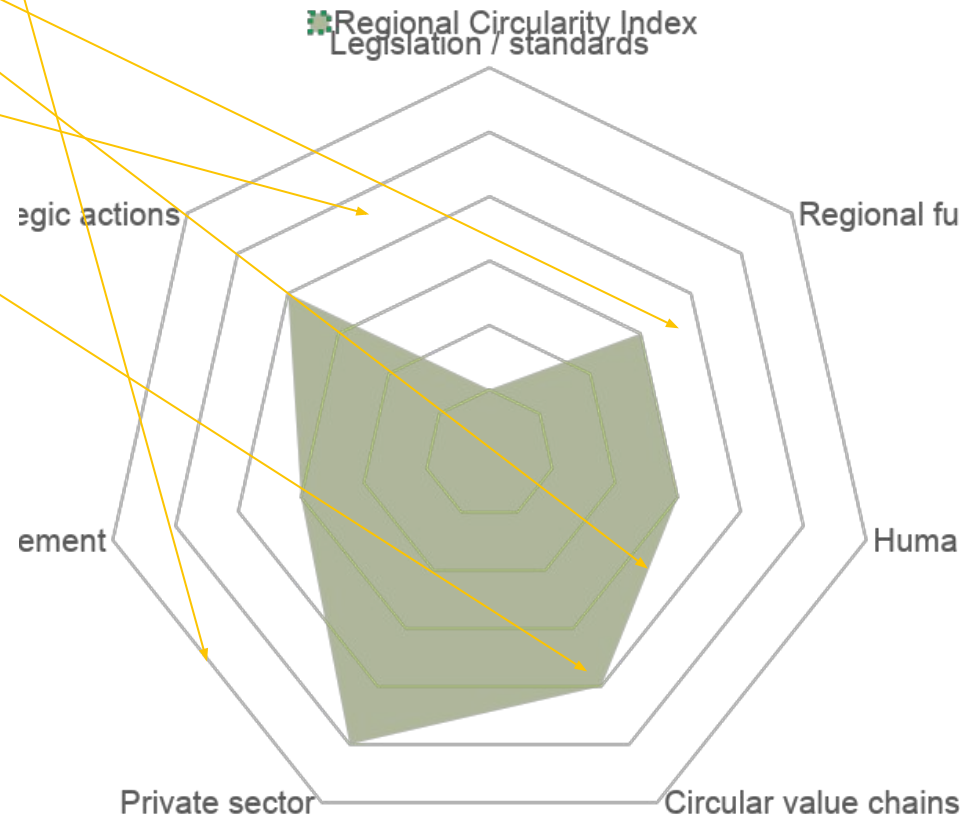
