







"Opportunities for West": Incentive Scheme for Bio-based Industry



This accessible scheme is designed to enable Small and Medium Enterprises (SME) to further develop or scale-up their Bio-based production processes, products or innovations. This includes the use of Biotech Campus Delft's facilities at Planet Bio or Bioprocess Pilot Facility.

Who can make use of the vouchers?

The target group is any SME established in a Member State of the European Union. The scheme's goal is to incentivize activities contributing to the transition from a fossil-based industry to a bio-based industry.

What are the three types of vouchers?

The establishment voucher is to be used by a SME to grow a Bio-based business that requires a location, ideally within a field lab/innovative ecosystem, where it makes use of the facilities on offer.

The growth voucher is to be used by the SME to obtain support in a research project to grow a Bio-based business. Vouchers are used to finance research on solving technoeconomic bottlenecks of a product or process of the SME or to provide support in the pre-piloting phase.

The pilot voucher is to be used by the SME to scale up a new Bio-based production process to a pilot. This involves making the first (dozens of) kilograms of a product, or testing a process for the first time with industrial equipment (instead of lab equipment).

Further specifications of the different vouchers are explained in the regulation on "Staatscourant".
