

- 14 from Ilia




PIANO STRATEGICO 2030

- □ CD-ETA Stakeholders Meetings have been connected with the valorization of natural and cultural heritage, thus favoring both the mutual exchange of experiences among local players of the sector and the development of innovative plans/policy measures by policy makers
- □ The Metropolitan City of Florence (CMF) was among the most interested participants, due to its 42 municipalities, all quite endowed with digitization products and services
- □ During the many Stakeholder meetings with the CMF, it started to take shape the idea to bring the outcomes of CD-ETA project inside the strategic plan of the Metropolitan City of Florence

The Strategic Plan of the Metropolitan City of Florence is made of different strategies and implemented through pilot projects: CD-ETA was selected amongst the others to the vision related "widespread opportunities", in order to offer its set of best practices for the digitization of cultural heritage aimed at valorizing and exploiting its potential in a tourism promotion perspective.

Among the many activities of the CD-ETA project, there have been specific moments dedicated to networking with initiatives potentially functional to capitalize the project outcomes. One of such initiatives refers to the Italian Technology Cluster "SmartCommunitiesTech, (CTN), which has also a focus on the cultural heritage and its promotion/diffusion by means of ICT tools

The above-mentioned plan is an orientation instrument, at disposal of Policy Makers such as MIUR (Ministry of Education, University and Research) and MISE (Ministry of Economic Development). Hopefully, it will be the road to a policy instrument action
