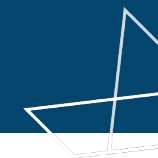

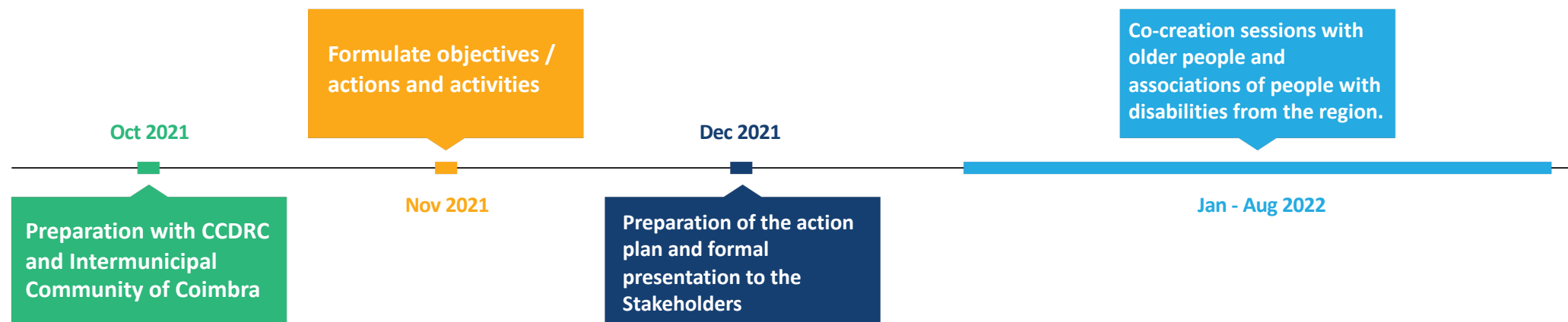
DESCRIPTION OF THE POLICY INSTRUMENT
