**ACTION 2: Change in the LAG Strategy** with the goal that projects for elderly have more chances to be granted / preparation of LAG project.

- 1st policy influence achieved: Change in the criteria for selecting operations to include vulnerable target groups (also elderly). The criteria was increased from 10 points to 15
- **Body responsible:** General Assembly of The inspiration from EU SHAFE project itself, stakeholder group meetings
  - Close work with managing authority LAG Heart of Slovenia resulted in preparation of new project idea proposal for LAG call.
  - "Drogheda and District Support 4 older people« (DDS4OP) from Louth, Ireland, influenced to the content of the new project.
  - Self defined performance indicator: New project for elderly approved on the LAG call
  - On 25th of March 2021, the General Assembly of LAG the Heart of Slovenia approved the "Point for the Elderly," and "Intergenerational Centre Javorje,"
  - Amount of funding influenced by the project: 64,490.53 EUR.
