



# MINUTES 5<sup>th</sup> study visit

#### Introduction

The EMOBICITY 5<sup>th</sup> study visit was organised by ADENE, Project Partner 5, and took place in Lisbon, on September 20<sup>th</sup> (Day 1 – Study Visit) and September 23<sup>rd</sup> (Day 2 - Study Visit closing meeting).

### Day 1

The welcome session was held at Lisbon Municipality's venue with the participation of representatives from Lisbon's City Council (Pedro Machado) and Lisbon's Municipal Energy Agency (Eduardo Silva).

Further on, Mr. Eduardo Silva provided an overview of e-mobility initiatives, activities and projects developed by Lisbon's City Council, empahysing the measures included in MOVE Lisboa - Strategic Vision for Mobility 2030, integrated planning and an management solution to transform the city and ensure the quality of life of its inhabitants and visitors. MOVE Lisboa is based on 6 pillars: integration, trust, accessibility, innovation and responsibility.

After this, the participantes visited an electric vehicle charging station hub, getting to know the main features of the electric mobility equipment managed by Lisbon's City Council. At this point, it was mentioned by Mr. Pedro Machado that the current infrastructure in Lisbon includes 645 normal charging plugs and 136 fast charging plugs and the goal for Lisbon in 2030 is to reach 10.000 plugs.





### Day 2

On September 23<sup>rd</sup> was held the Study Visit closing meeting, which started with an welcome speech from Mr. Nelson Lage, Chairman of the Board of Directors of ADENE. During his speech, among others, he addressed as key points to be highlighted that: Portugal is strongly committed to the energy transition, that should be fair and competitive; EMOBICITY project goals are fully aligned with the Portuguese Government's

intentions, as well as with ADENE's mission to develop and enforce activities under public policies and promote energy efficiency, including energy efficiency in mobility; EMOBICITY project reveals to be an excellent opportunity to closely collaborate with the regional public administration (e.g. Azores).

Afterwards, there was a networking session where each partner had the opportunity to comment and express their opinion on the main achievments of the overall study visit to Portugal (Lisbon and Ponta Delgada). It was also the occasion to review what had been developed in each country, and to forecast how EMOBICITY project can contribute to a
