On the verge of ending Phase 1, RESINDUSTRY has already reached the following results during the 5th semester:

- The final version of the Regional Assessment has been posted on the RESINDUSTRY website, including information regarding the current state of renewable energy use within all partner regions.
- 15 <u>Best practices</u> were approved by the Policy Learning Platform, as relevant examples of how issues related to Renewable Energy Sources are being developed in the partner's regions.
- Several project meetings have taken place, such as Local Stakeholder
 Meetings or Policy Breakfasts, where the consortium members and the
 management authorities held debates on the key actions to be included in the
 Action Plans.

RESINDUSTRY will soon start working on the following new actions.

- Expert Missions, where an exchange of knowledge among experts from different regions will provide tailor-made training based on each region's requests
- Continuation of actions such as Policy breakfasts and Local Stakeholders meetings all along the 6th Semester.
- Two **Study Visits** (Poland and Gozo (Malta)), which were delayed due to the COVID 19 pandemic, will also take place next semester.


