



Stakeholder Training – Energy on Farms

Teagasc and IT Sligo have developed a pilot training programme for Teagasc Farm Advisors which applies to Strands 1 and 2, i.e. to target and optimise existing policy supports and replicate existing Good Practices.




Fig 1.1 – Training strategy

The outline strategy & structure is illustrated in Fig 1.1. The objective of the training mirrors that of the AgroRES project, i.e. to encourage the uptake of appropriate renewable technologies in the Agricultural sector by clarifying the routes to exploitation. The Teagasc Advisory service is a well-established structure providing a wide range of practical, financial, technical and environmental training opportunities for farming and farm family members. As such the Teagasc Advisors are an ideal pathway to reaching the appropriate farming community.






Fig 1.2 – Learning outcomes for trainees
