


10 Crises in a 2-Generations-Overview

- ATTRACTISS (Horizon Europe, CSA): Innovation in Agriculture, 2022-2028
- Green Energy Lab (Climate & Energy Fund): Austria's largest innovation laboratory for a sustainable energy future
- SMART CIRCUIT Initiative: Applications on Digital Circular Economy
 - Starting phase: 48 partners
 - Cross-programme setting: ~180Mio 1st wave

System Architecture

- Anchor structures and processes: in/between/among regions
 - Cross-sectoral training schemes
 - Transnational curricula, education & mobility
- Address regional, national, European policy makers (1) to gain a critical mass (2) for a continous strategic and operative cooperation
 - > Establish a sound communication and transfer mechanism
 - Use full EU Financial Scheme
