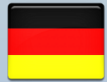


commercial activity (renting space for offices, guest rooms, organization of events, conferences, trainings) enabling the maintenance of historic buildings and employees

Public sector and NGO's cooperating for valorisation of the Cultural Park "Town of Weavers".

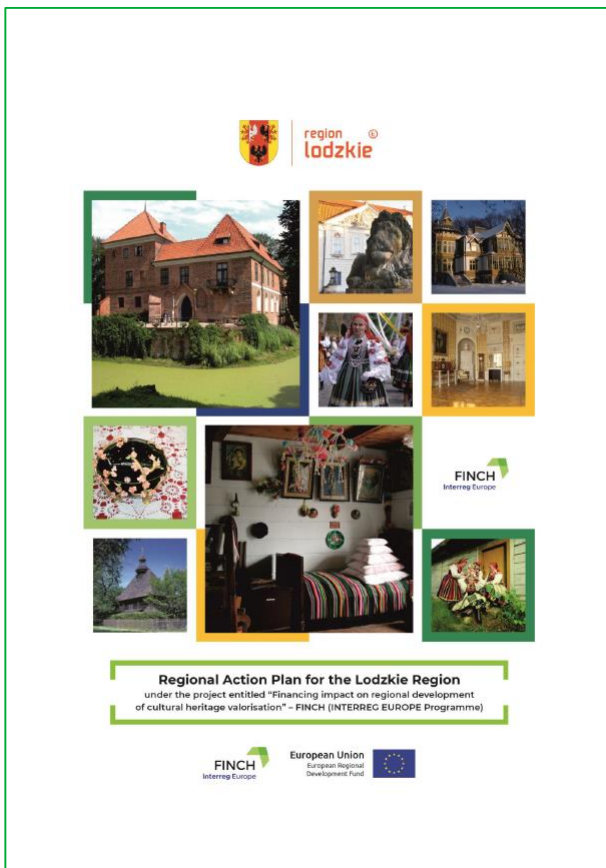


cooperation of the local government with NGOs and other institutions;

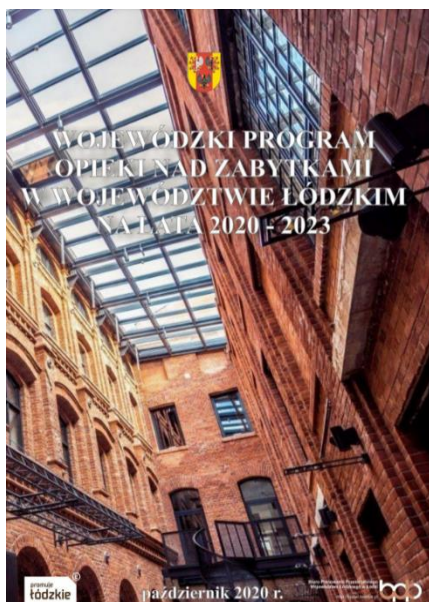

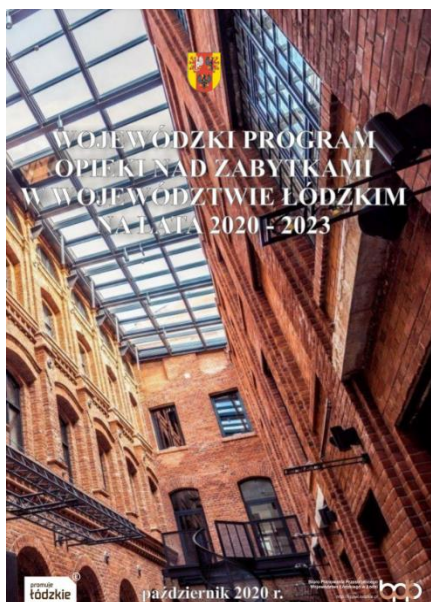

## Action 1 Incorporation of the FINCH solutions in the “Regional Programme for the Protection of Historical Monuments in the Lodzkie Region for 2020- 2023”

The program defines the conditions for including monuments in the processes of economic development of the region with the participation of various entities. It has been planned for implementation with the use of many sources of financing, both public and private, including national resources, local government units, EU structural funds. As part of action 1, it was planned to disseminate knowledge and inspire public and private entities in the region to use new organizational and financial solutions, based on the experiences of the FINCH project partners.

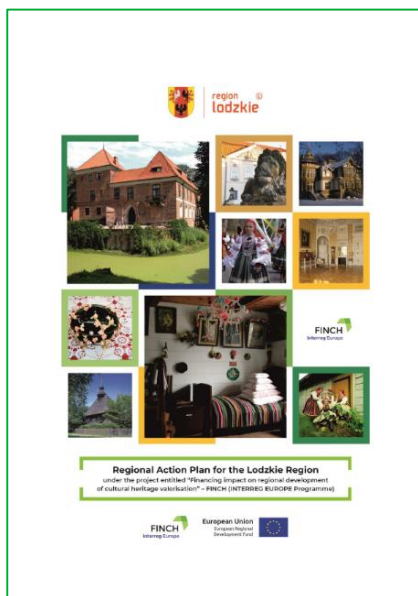
