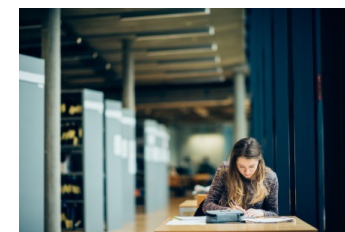

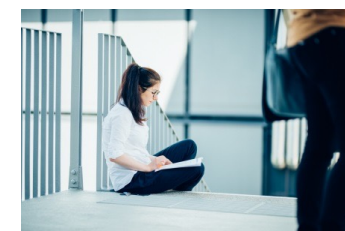

- ★ Currently more than 7,400 students from 83 different countries are enrolled.
- ★ Average age: 39 years.
- ★ Since the foundation in 1995 over 29,000 students have graduated.
- ★ Up to 200 studies allocated in 3 faculties.
- ★ 720 employees,
of which the academic staff comprises 374 individuals
external lecturers: 929
(Status: 31 December 2021)
- ★ Budget: 53 million euros
59% financed by admission fees and research funds
41% supported by the Federal Government
and the Province of Lower Austria

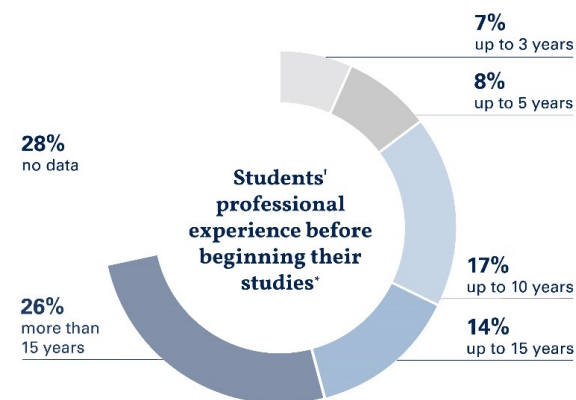
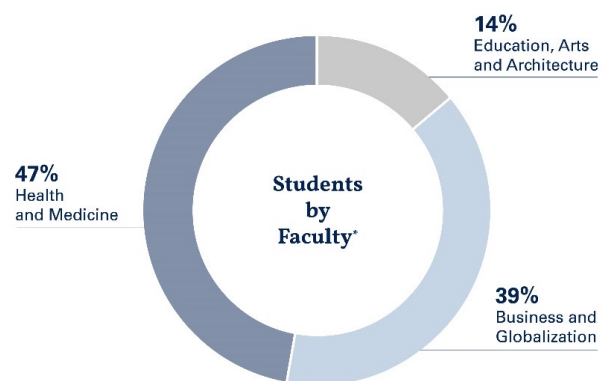
