#### **PROVINCE OF ZARAGOZA**

MOMAr's lead partner, the **Province of Zaragoza**, presented its Action Plan focusing on the important **salt heritage** of Remolinos. The main objective is to enhance this exceptional heritage to develop the village, promote its knowledge and the sense of belonging of the local population, and use it as a way to raise awareness about other assets of the town.

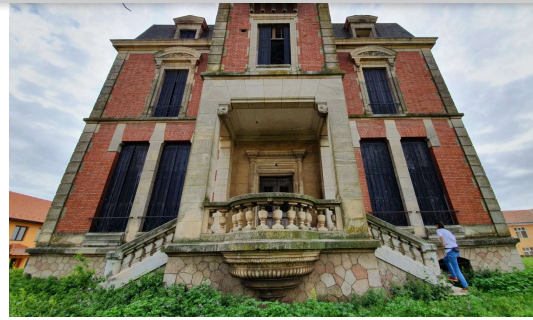
### GRONINGEN
