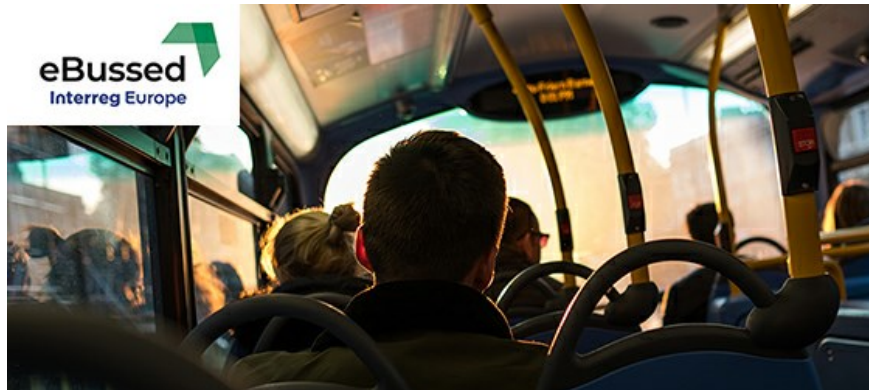

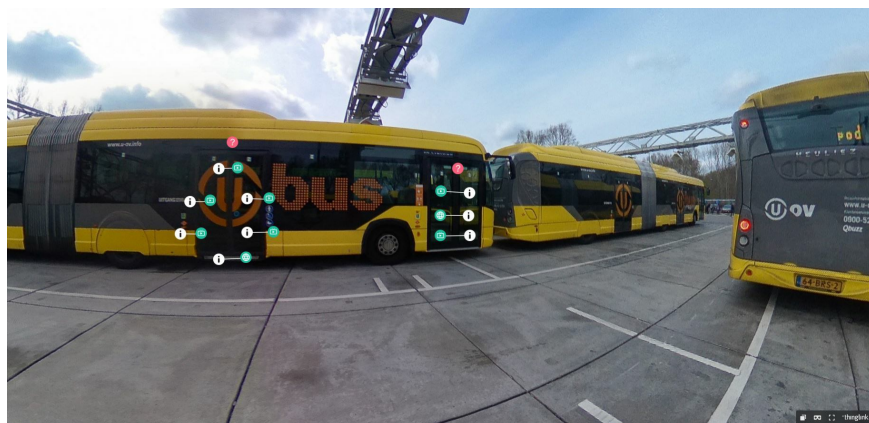


eBussed is ready to start the second round!
