Government Decisions no. 30/2020 & 32/2020

measures taken in the context of the COVID-19 pandemic to support:

- employers whose activity was partially or totally interrupted (when the state of emergency was declared)
- employers who do not have the capacity to pay the salaries of all employees (max. 75% of the total employees)

Employees benefits are set at 75% of the basic salary, corresponding for the job, and are supported by the unemployment insurance budget, but not more than 75% of the average gross earnings provided by the State Social Insurance Budget Law for the year 2020 (not more than 800 EUR)

Government Decision no. 130 / 2020



Competitiveness Operational Program 2014/2020

financial support from non-reimbursable external funds for beneficiaries whose activity has been affected by the spread of the SARS-CoV-2 virus or whose activity has been banned by military ordinances during the state of emergency or restricted during the alert state.

- micro-grants in the form of a lump sum;
- grants for working capital in the form of a lump sum and as a percentage of the turnover;
- grants for productive investments based on the evaluation of the submitted investment project.

<u>Beneficiaries</u>: SMEs, private medical offices, NGO with economic activity

MICROGRANTS: 2000 € for SMEs with 0 employees



Financing: 100 %

Turnover: at least 5,000 EUR

Important aspects: company with profit in 2019, 0 employees in 2019 & min. 1 year of activity

Eligible costs: raw materials, debts to state budget, rental costs, medical protection equipment, etc.

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Eligible areas: eligible CAENs: all

GRANTS FOR WORKING CAPITAL for SMEs lump sum € 2,000 – € 150,000





Grants:

- € 2,000 SMEs with a turnover between € 5,000 and € 13,500 in 2019
- 15% of the turnover and no more than € 150,000 SMEs with a turnover between € 13,501 € 1,000,000, in 2019
- € 150,000 for SMEs with a turnover of more than EUR 1.000.000

Co-financing: min. 15%

Important aspects: company with profit in 2018 or 2019, emergency certificate obtained.

Eligible costs: raw materials, debts to state budget, rent costs, medical protection equipment, etc.

Eligible areas: multiple, including restaurants, hotels, cafes, food industry and other related activities, travel agencies, creative industries, and event organizations, etc.

GRANTS FOR INVESTMENTS & ECONOMIC RECONVERSION of SMEs



Grant: 50,000 € - 200000 €

Co-financing: min. 15% (30% for beneficiaries from Bucharest-Ilfov Region)

Important aspects: company with profit in 2018 or 2019, min. 1 year of activity at the date of the application for funding.

Eligible costs: construction, equipment, software, website, furniture, lands max. 10% of the project, consulting and design, licenses, etc.

Eligible areas: multiple, including tourism, guesthouses, hotels, restaurants and leisure services including specific leisure infrastructure.

<u>Beneficiaries</u>: SMEs affected by COVID-19 pandemic from several economic sectors, including hotels & restaurants / health & social assistance








Grant: 20% of the loss suffered in turnover in 2020 vs 2019

Financing: 100 %

Important aspects:


mmaintaining the activity for at least 6 months from the date of signing the grant contract (if the law does not establish restrictions that could impose the suspension or undertaking of the commercial activity)






Decrease in the number of tourists arrival in 2020 compared to 2019
