REPORT OF THE DISCUSSION

The Lazio Region organized the Regional Event reserved for Stakeholders on 15 July 2022, which was held at the historic "We Gil" regional headquarters in Rome. The event was organized by the Lazio Region as part of the REPLACE project as stakeholders meeting for the sixth semester of the project. The organization of the event was to relate the territory and the stakeholders involved in relation to the projects of the Replace project and which activities and which results were addressed within the issues of the transition to the circular economy, as a development factor fundamental economic for our territory, which allows us to face climate and energy challenges.

The goal was to create a profitable dialogue with the territory and local stakeholders in order to better organize the 2021-2027 regional programming being defined in recent months. After this first session of the event, the tools currently available to facilitate the ecological transition within the framework of the Circular Economy were also presented. Fundamental to this goal was the comparison and collaboration with the DigiPrime project. The event was part of the First International Summer School dedicated to Circular Economy, which took place between 11 and 15 July 2022 in Rome.

CONCLUSIONS

Fundamental point of the stakeholders meeting, also in function of the timing within the sixth semester was to start a constructive dialogue between the political actors and the reality present in the territory in view of the drafting of the next Regional Operational Program of the Lazio Region.
