


Low Carbon Economy LC DISTRICTS



Strengths of LC DISTRICTS

- Topic high on the EU agenda (low carbon districts)
- Clear focus on Structural Funds programmes
 (all policy instruments)
- Achievements so far: 25 GPs published on the project website,
 75 people with increased capacity, 5 action plans
- Strong resilience against the consequences of the COVID crisis






