Thessaloniki, Greece, 09-11 May 2022 7th Project meeting, Workshop and Study Visit

Day 1, 09/05/2022

On the 09th of May, all project partners met in person for the 7th EMOBICITY Project Meeting. The meeting took place at the Electra Palace Hotel in Thessaloniki, from 09:30-12:00, according to schedule. All partners participated in the meeting while NWRDA, were represented by the project team of CIVITTA (subcontractors of NWRDA for the development of their Action Plan).

The meeting started with the presentation by the LP (CRES) of the project's overall progress, including the achievement of the project's KPIs and targets, pending issues, remaining activities for Semester 6, overall progress regarding the Action Plans and detailed information on the recent Mid-Term review meeting with the JS.

Then each partner took the floor and presented its activities during Semesters 5 and 6, focusing especially on the elaboration of their Action Plans.

Among other, several issues were discussed, including important activities pointed out by the JS like the On-The-Spot-Checks that need to be fulfilled by the end of Phase 1, requirements for Phase 2, the need to finalise the Peer-Reviews etc

After the end of the project meeting, a city tour took place related to e-mobility and sustainable transport while learning at the same time the history of the city of Thessaloniki.

At the end of the day, all partners and invited stakeholders had a dinner and a great opportunity to discuss on the project progress and further exchange ideas for improvements .

Day 2, 10/05/2022

On the 10th of May, the 7th EMOBICITY Thematic Workshop took place at the Electra Palace Hotel in Thessaloniki, from 09:00-14:30, both physically and online to allow greater participation of attendees that could not travel to Greece for the event. In total, about 75 participants attended the workshop (35 participants on site and 40 participants online).

During the first session of the workshop, Dr Lambros Pyrgiotis (General Director of CRES), Dr Efthymios Bakogiannis (Secretary General Spatial Planning and Urban Environment, Ministry of Environment and Energy), Mr Paris Billias (Deputy Regional Minister of Infrastructure and Networks of the Region of Central Macedonia) and Mr Dimitris Papastergiou (President of the Central Union of Municipalities of Greece), presented the current status of e-mobility in Greece and future plans for the further deployment of EVs and charging infrastructure, demonstrating the necessary engagement at a high political level.

After the end of this first session, Mr **Ioannis Tselikis** (Head of e-mobility office, Ministry of Environment and Energy) presented the **GO ELECTRIC** subsidies programme and e-mobility developments in Greece, followed by Mrs **Maria Zarkadoula** (Head of Environment & Transport dept, CRES) presenting the **EMOBICITY** project and Dr **Georgios Ageridis** (Head of Energy Efficiency Division, CRES) who presented the **Micromobility programme for Municipalities**.





After a short break, Prof. Nikolaos Papanikolaou (Dimokritio University of Thrace) presented the new e-mobility program ILEKTRODOTO, Mrs Kalliopi Papadaki (General Directorate of Urban Planning, Ministry of Environment and Energy) presented insights on the relationship between e-mobility and spatial planning and Mr Evangelos Fragakis, (Mayor of the island of Chalki) presented the innovative activities that take place on the island including the ChalkiOn Energy Community that offers clean energy for charging EVs on the island through a recently installed PV park.

Mr Papastergios Georgios, (Deputy Head of Operational Planning and Development Programmes Monitoring Dept., Municipality of Thessaloniki) presented thoroughly the latest development in the city of **Thessaloniki** regarding **e-mobility and sustainable mobility**, while **Mr. Carlos Martins (**EDA Electricidade Dos Açores), presented the innovative **V2G Azores project.**

Finally, **Dr Anastasios Kyritsis** (Professor, Ionio University) presented some of the latest **research and technology trends in e-mobility,** followed by **Dr George Asimopoulos** (Industrial Property Organisation) who gave an interesting presentation on the **EVs patent landscape** and **Dr Christos Tourkolias**, (CRES) who gave a presentation on **e-mobility and Energy Communities Business Models.**

The workshop gained extremely high visibility, as the national TV channel ERT3 wanted to cover the event and as a result, several speakers gave interviews, promoting further EMOBICITY and e-mobility.





Day 3, 11/05/2022

On the 11th of May, all partners and invited stakeholders gathered in order to participate at the planned Study Visits in Thessaloniki.

The first stop has been to MC Chargers, a Greek company operating in the field of charging stations manufacturing. Representatives of the company gave a presentation on charging stations specifications, standards, manufacturing steps and barriers/problems associated with EV charging infrastructure. Next, the participants visited the manufacturing shop floor and had the chance to check what a charging station consists of and were also informed on the necessary manufacturing steps.

The second part of the Study Visit took place at the parking station of Thessaloniki Concert Hall. The participants had the opportunity to check an electric car and an e-bike (for EV sharing purposes) while the representative from Brainbox company – which specializes in EV related software applications – explained and demonstrated the operation of the EV sharing scheme.

A great promotion event was organized at the same time in the parking area, where journalists from the national TV channel ERT3 were invited to cover the event while the representative of Brainbox gave an interview mentioning EMOBICITY and presenting the benefits of e-mobility.


