#### Survey context


#### Analysis of the **impact of COVID-19 on the internationalization of SMEs** and **the public policy instrument**.

✓ The interview with the Intermediate Body on public policy instrument.













How has the COVID-19 pandemic affected your business in the last year and a half?








Have you developed new measures within the company to counter the impact of COVID-19? Please list measures also related to your import / export activity.








Have you removed products and/or services from your portfolio due to COVID-19?








Have you introduced new products and/or services due to COVID-19?










Have you made changes to the way you work every day?













Have you applied for structural support during the COVID-19 pandemic? If so, please select or mention the type of support you received.

#### Original policy instrument addressed



**Regional Operational Program 2014-2020** 

Priority Axis 2 – Increasing the competitiveness of SMEs, Specific Objective - 2.2. Support the creation and expansion of advanced manufacturing capability and development services

- **u** the initial support measures of the instrument have not been modified;
- no new measures have been developed;
- extension of the state aid scheme;
- □ the list of eligible NACE codes was upgraded;
- the derogation from the eligibility criteria regarding the applicant's uninterrupted/suspended activity for a period corresponding to at least one full fiscal year was temporarily accepted.





#### Pandemic impact on policy instrument and on Management Authority/Intermediary Body (quantitative analysis)

#### **u** the most typical challenges for SMEs were:

- suspension of the operation of SMEs during the application of measures to prevent the spread of COVID-19 (state of emergency/alert).
- adapting the company's activities to telework.
- digitization of processes.
- **communication and promotion through online platforms**
- consumers have drastically changed their buying habits mainly looking online for local supply.





#### New policy instrument addressed on the 5<sup>th</sup> call

#### South Muntenia Regional Development Plan 2021-2027

RDP 2021-2027 is the instrument by which the region promotes its priorities and interests in the economic and social fields – it is the main strategic planning instrument, developed at regional level and contributes to the elaboration of the ROP.

- The plan has been improved and upgraded based on the examples of good practice presented in the UpGradeSME project;
- The need for regional companies to be supported to access international markets through grants and the provision of dedicated support services was highlighted;
- Indicative actions were considered in this regard like grants for the development of feasibility studies and market research, for export plans or matchmaking activities, for innovation and digitization, etc.
