IMPLEMENTATION OF THE ACTION PLAN



Background

Action: Enhancing the existing energy efficiency measure database to increase monitoring effectiveness and energy efficiency in SME

→ As identified in the Action plan in phase 1 of the project SMEplus, the existing energy efficiency database needed to be modernized and help to better coordinate the measures nationwide.

Intention



The main objectives of this action was to

- modernize the existing database and
- coordinate the measurements with all of the other federal states in Austria.

Current status:

- The modernization of the existing database is still important for the region and
- is also being implemented together with all of Austria's federal states as part of a coordinated process.

4	 Finally, the database is established and adapted to the processes of the individual federal states to create a greater network. → Implementation phase Information and training of the new database for energy consultants Activity to reach out to the users of the database (Gaining potential new users, mapping for regional users, networking) 	€ 10.000,00	Since more difficulties and change requests were identified during the evaluation phase, the full programming could not be completed yet. Therefore, this phase is still open.

Current status:

- The planned stakeholders were involved in the whole process.
- There was a change of the institution of the "Regional program management of Burgenland". The program is not managed from Forschung Burgenland anymore and is now managed by FIB (Forschung und Innovation Burgenland).

SMEPlus Interreg Europe

Time frame

- **Evaluation phase** → This step already started in 2018. However, the evaluation phase and analyzing the needs, as well as a cost forecast, has already taken one to two years. The result was a concept for the new database. → **completed**
- Programming phase → At the end of 2019, it was possible to commission the programming of the new database, which is expected to be finished at the beginning of 2022. → Basic programming completed; involvement of feedback ongoing; phase is extended
- **Assessment phase** → Parallel to the programming phase, the program managers of the federal states are involved in assessment meetings with the programming company. → ongoing; phase is extended
- Implementation phase → The implementation phase of the new database will be simultaneously with the implementation phase of the project SMEplus. Currently, the implementation is planned beginning from January 2022. In this phase, the new database can be involved in the processes of the region and, based on the best practise example, the energy efficiency network can be further developed. → ongoing; phase is extended
