






Solyval

Solyval is the first company in the Indian Ocean area to recover and recycle used tyres. For 15 years, SOLYVAL has been the top company established in Réunion in the recovery and recycling of used tyres. More than 6,000 tonnes of used tyres are transformed each year. The goal is to absorb more than 50% of the recycled aggregate deposit and transform it into moulded products for the local and regional market. https://www.solygom.re/en/solygom-2/



ALIE OTE BIKE

Oté Bike is a permanent integration workshop which trains more than twenty employees per year in the assembly and electrification of cycles. Solidarity and eco-responsible, Oté Bike also aims to promote the use of bicycles to encourage business travel and the transport of goods. The VIMR resource center is a structure that allows you to collect objects that are no longer used by their owners. It has a recovery, recovery and resale centre. Priority is given to the reduction, reuse and recycling of waste, it also helps to raise public awareness of respect for the environment. La Ressourcerie sets up the collection of objects and their recovery with the aim of reusing or even recycling them. La Ressourcerie has a social vocation, it acts on local development by creating jobs and develops a network with many partnerships around the solidarity economy.
