




#### Legal study

#### Action plan




Policy instrument adressed: The ADEME (National and Environmental and Energy Management Agency) bestowed upon the Metropolis of Lyon the responsibility to distribute the funds from the "Fonds chaleur national" that derives from the national "Renewable Heat Agreement". This fund aims at financing renewable heat projects

1: selection of an existing local citizen non profit organisation as basis for including renewable heat

2: study of the potential opportunities in the area and a financing plan

3: training the citizen cooperative on the specifics of renewable heat, namely one training on the technical and financial insights and one on the legal aspects with the help of the legal study carried out within the SHREC project.

4: the cooperative that has been accompanied all along the way, is expected to produce an opportunity study including the financial simulation for a specific project idea.
