THE BACKGROUND OF THE ACTION PLAN: ENERGY SAVING IN CAMPUSES AND LEGAL ISSUES

MAIN BOTTLENECKS IDENTIFIED WITH THE SELF ASSEMENT TOOLS

1) Lack of adequate economic resources

Ordinary procurements require full payment from the contracting authority

2) Administrative burdens and legal complexity

Use of inadequate legal instruments (e.g. EPC / Public work contracts) Lack of knowledge of innovative instruments Very complex regulatory frameworks



THE ACTION PLAN



The Action Plan aims to improve the Regional Energy Plan of Friuli Venezia Giulia by activating a broader and innovative use of PPP and IP in energy efficiency interventions in University campuses and, also with regard to other public buildings



THE GUIDELINES ON PPP



The guidelines are intended to foster a consistent knowledge and use of PPP by public administrations, in order to boost energy efficiency in public buildings (starting form university campuses) or/and to increase the use of renewable energy sources

They improve the governance of the policy instrument, ensuring a broader and stronger activation of PPP


The draft guidelines were elaborated during three meetings of the Expert Table, on the basis of a constant work of its components, from September 2022 to March 2023

The Guidelines are to be definitively adopted by the Executive board of the Region by the end of July 2023
