



Limited number of regions exchanging and transferring practices on a shared regional development issue





Leveraging European Funding in Small Urban Areas

- Small Urban Areas (SUAs) are defined as towns with a population between 5,000 and 50,000 inhabitants
- → context-dependent (<u>Böhme et al.</u>).
- SUAs are highly diverse and collectively house **43% of the EU's population.**
- SUAs face a broad spectrum of societal challenges, including an ageing population, brain drain, climate change, digital transition, and socio-economic transformation.

Leveraging European Funding in Small Urban Areas

- Until recently, European policies have overlooked SUAs, leaving them feeling neglected.
- To access European funding effectively, SUAs must
 - Cultivate **leadership** capable of mobilising their communities
 - Develop institutional and legal capacities to punch above their weight, and
 - Cultivate **resilience** to navigate uncertainties.


