How to use the kit

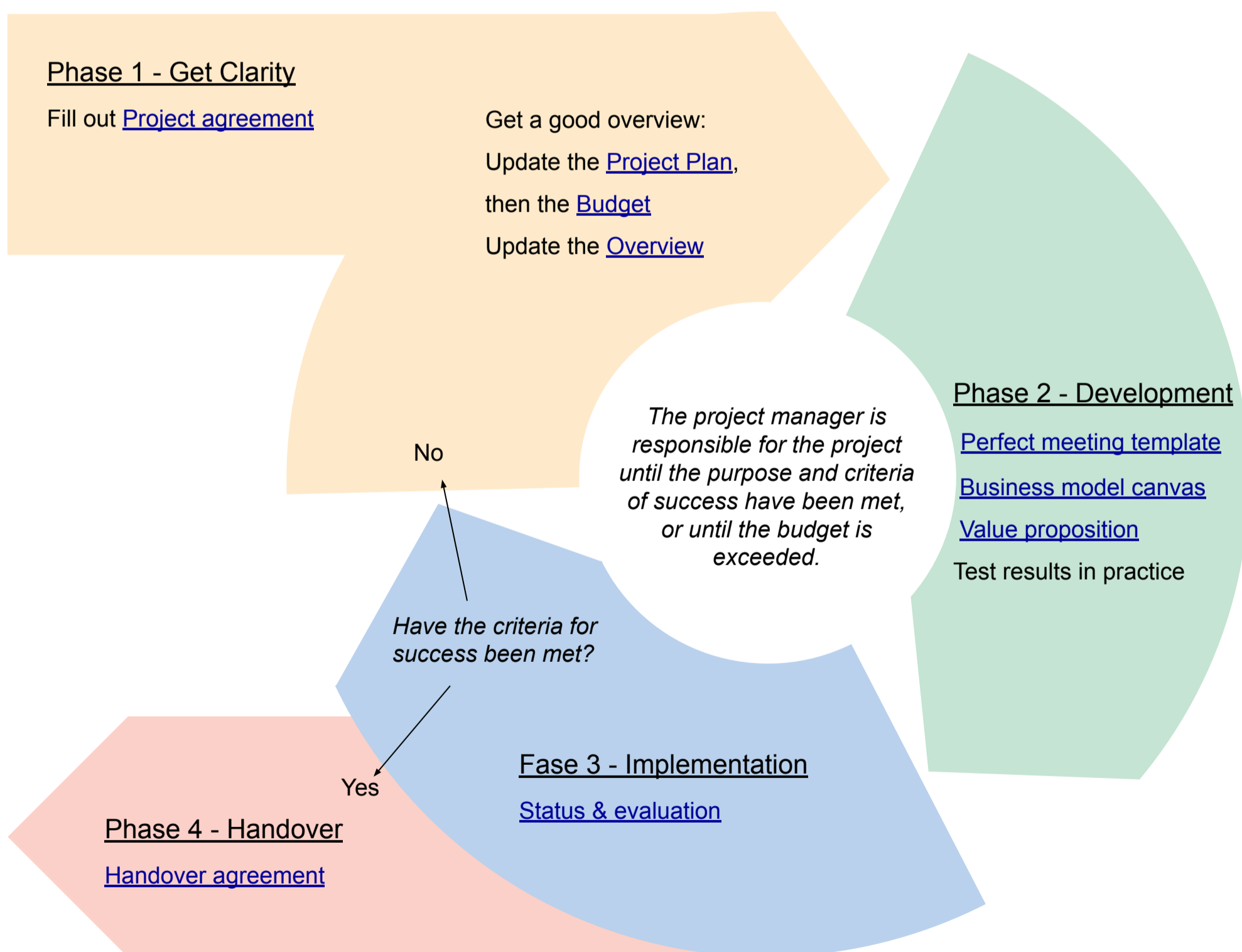
