## Regional Innovation Governance Introduction

- Regional innovation governance is all the processes of interactions among various actors that together determine the priorities, strategies, activities and outcomes in research and innovation at the regional level.
- Regional innovation governance consists of a large view of the rules, actions and institutions meant to coordinate the regional innovation ecosystems.
- Novel policy paradigms such as Mission-Oriented Innovation Policy (MOIP), Responsible Research and Innovation (RRI), Smart Specialisation Strategies for Sustainable and Inclusive Growth (S4+), and Transformative Innovation Policy (TIP) imply more inclusive and experimental governance models to solve societal challenges.
- The OECD observatory of public sector innovation (OPSI) introduced the concept of anticipatory innovation governance.
