General Council. Is the supreme organ of the Association, composed of all members. Its powers are controlling the management of the Executive Committee and approve the budget of the AIMRD and action plans.

Executive Committee. It comprises the President and eight Vice-Presidents (four Spanish, Laguna de Duero, Aranda de Duero, Duruelo de la Sierra, Valladolid, and four Portuguese, Vila Nova de Gaia, Porto, Miranda do Douro and Castelo de Paiva).

This is the body responsible for implementing the agreements and resolutions adopted by the General Council. Prepares the meetings of this body and makes the proposed plans, budgets and fees.
