The Avitem engages in ZEROCO2

The Agency for Sustainable Mediterranean Cities and Territories is participating in the ZEROCO2 project, which aims to engage public decision-makers from different European regions in reducing carbon emissions in new or renovated buildings in order to accelerate the transition to sustainable development. Through interregional cooperation, the regions will identify, exchange and share a set of innovative methods, technologies, processes and good practices for zero CO2 buildings.



The fight against CO2 emissions will determine the future of our planet. Buildings contribute to one third of the EU's total greenhouse gas emissions, mainly because of the use of fossil fuels and natural gas to meet heating, cooling and electricity requirements. That is why Europe has launched the ZEROCO2 project via the Interreg Europe program, which is to define a new standard for buildings with zero carbon emissions due to energy consumption.
