Some facts



In 1991 the average EU citizen bought 34 garments in a year, in 2007 that had risen to 67 (one every 4-5 days)

2 billion pairs of jeans are produced globally each year

On average, it takes 7,000 litres of water to make one pair of jeans

It takes 2,700 litres of water to make one T shirt

Over 8,000 different synthetic chemicals are used to turn raw materials into

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Some facts



Over 20% of all global water pollution comes from textile manufacturing

80 billion pieces of clothing are produced globally each year

85% of discarded clothing ends up in landfill

In the EU, the average person discards 32 kg of clothing each year

10% of all new clothing is never sold, never worn and goes straight to landfill.

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Rationale



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- Business sustainability is becoming one of the most important objectives of the T&C industry.
- Right balance of investment and benefits across the “people, planet and profit” aspects of sustainability.
- Networking between regional and local authorities, T&C clusters and R&D centers and other stakeholders is an essential part of the transition to a more sustainable future.
- Sharing experiences across EU linking technological evolution of products and processes with a more sustainable approach to the market.

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Main objective

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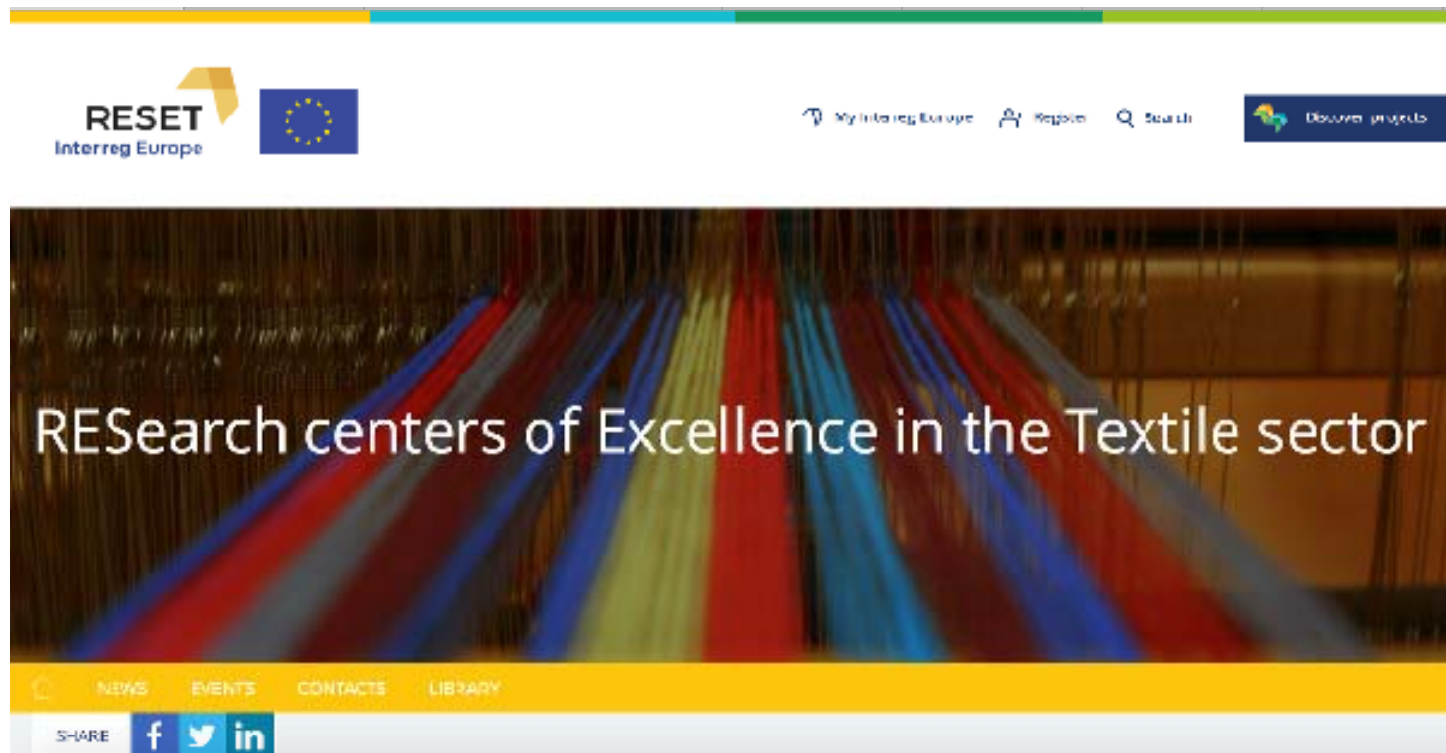
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
