THE PROJECT

WINPOL is a European project that fosters the use of intelligent equipment and policies in municipal waste management. The project is organised in two phases:

1. Interregional learning (2018-2020): partners identify and exchange good practices, conduct study visits and incorporate the knowledge into concrete action plans.
2. Implementation (2020-2022): partners put into action the knowledge acquired and monitor and report on their results, sharing solutions with other European cities and regions.
