Short report of the meeting.

The meeting took place in Start-up city at the Hanze University, it started at 15.00 o'clock and ended at 16.30 o'clock. The atmosphere was very pleasant.

The following points have been discussed:

Introduction of the members of the stakeholders group.

Discussion and clarification regarding the minutes from last time, they were accepted by the members.

The members who visited BRNO presented their report; they were enthusiastic about the visit and program, although they found it rather passive. This was relevant since in December the E-Cool community will visit Groningen and this group needs to prepare this.

During the visit in BRNO, Seville indicated that it might be a good idea to swap the visiting dates between Estonia and The Netherlands. This was discussed rather lengthily and the conclusion was that chairman Mr. Mertens will send a letter to Seville and indicate that Hanze University prefers to welcome the community in December 2019.

Mr. Mertens presented a best practice which was organised on Dec 11th 2018 which united different groups. The link to the meeting is here

The group accepted an entrepreneurial experience 6 till 26. The group indicated that it was important to have a methodology to connect different levels and interests. The idea is to use the method "Critical friends" and to work the method out in detail. Part of the critical friend method is a number of training (such as host on the serendipitytable).

The SNN indicated that more material is available, this was happily accepted by the members. The group indicated that they would like to know more and it was decided that possibilities will be identified to investigate the potentialities for sharing knowledge among institutions.


