Umbria Region event

On 18 April the Region held a communications event in Perugia presenting its experience with the Urban Agenda (the SHARE policy).

Carlo Cipiciani, the MA contact for the project, cited the value of the exchanges and research carried out during Phase 1 in his presentation.

Implementation slows...

Elections: Two of the 5 urban agenda cities held municipal elections in late May. The months-long election process impeded meaningful participation of those municipalities in the work of SHARE during the semester.

Political crisis: Sudden resignation of the President of the Region in April. Early elections were scheduled for 28 October. From April until November, many Regional initiatives were suspended and only routine administrative activities performed. Besides the distraction and uncertainty related to the political crisis, LAP activities require engagement by the municipal staff with coordination and oversight by the MA, and so these have been slowed.

Umbria Monitoring Jan-June 2019

Action 1 Improved communication among 5 municipalities

Monitoring: 1 meeting with MA + municipalities on 3 April Foligno

Objective: define and assess indicators for each semester

Indicators: number of people, degree of improvement.

Evidence: minutes, agenda, signature sheet

Output: 1 report per semester

Action 2 Establishment of network of people working on Urban Agenda

Monitoring: 1 meeting (vs target of 2) with stakeholders on 3 April Foligno

Indicators: number of people, list of ideas and proposals.

Evidence: internal reports about improvements discussed, agenda, signature sheet

Output: 1 report per semester

Action 3 Topical Champions

Monitoring: 1 meeting per semester with stakeholders (MA + municipalities) on 3 April Foligno *Indicators:* quantitative to be agreed by each municipality; qualitative: improvement of quality of life, better use of funds, new developments.

Evidence: grid of quantitative indicators, official reports on quality of life topics, if possible

Output: 1 report per semester per municipality, with qual/quant indicators, description of analysis method

Action 4 Messaging

Monitoring: 1 meeting per semester with MA on 3 April Foligno

Indicators: quantitative: people involved in meeting, citizens reached by messaging campaigns; qualitative: content of campaigns, plus list of media and testimonials involved.

Evidence: signature lists and agendas, any official data reports, collection of media and materials

Output: 1 report per meeting; one report per year on impact of campaign
