Zasavje Region

- The Zasavje region lies in the heart of Slovenia, by the middle course of the Sava river and is surrounded by numerous hills and mountains among which the highest is Kum.
- It consists of three municipalities – Hrastnik, Trbovlje, and Zagorje ob Savi.
- It is known as an industrial region, thanks to along coal mining and glass-making tradition, as well as thermal electricity plant and chemical factory.



Regional Development Agency Zasavje

- Established by the three municipalities, the RDA Zasavje is the main (public) institution responsible for regional development of the Zasavje development region for the time period 2014–2020.
- Responsible for general development tasks, regional development program, the regional development agreement and regional projects.
- Professional and technical assistance for the functioning of the Council of the region, Regional development council and management of the regional development network.
- Implements instruments within the framework of the Competitiveness and Development Assistance Program for the area of municipalities Hrastnik, Radeče and Trbovlje in the time period 2013 – 2020.

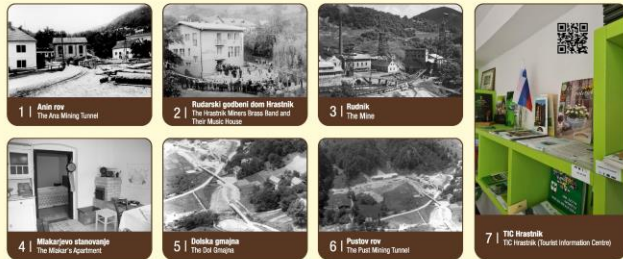
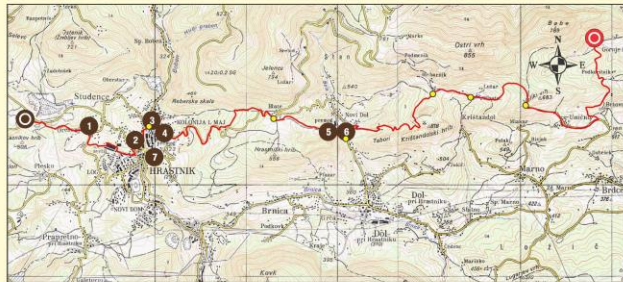
Tematsko-turistična pohodna pot / Themed Tourist Hiking Trail

- Hiking trail through 4 municipalities – interregional connection of Zasavje with Savinjska region – Laško municipality.
- Common topic of mining – with informative signs about interesting sights, significant to the mining tradition.

- Exploring the foundation of our mining towns – labour and working class.



Reasons for participation and expected outcomes of the RAMSAT project

Why?

- Necessary to remind of and preserve our cultural and natural heritage.
- Emphasize tourism as a next step in our economical development.
- *Build a network of stakeholders.*

Expected outcomes

- Connecting the local agents – local authorities, companies, associations.
- An increased number of visitors in our region.
- Inclusion of tourism and heritage related projects in our Regional development programme.

Potential for sustainable alternative tourism

Focus on cultural, adventure, and rural tourism

- Hiking, trekking pathways, downhill trails.
 - E. g. themed tourist hiking trail „Pot Srečno“ through four municipalities; circular trekking or cycling path through rural area – „Rabbit’s“ trail – including activities for children; walkway from town of Hrastnik to the village of Dol pri Hrastniku.

- Cultural – industrial heritage included in tourism.
 - E. g. the Labour Film Festival; revitalizing former mining premises to be used by local community and tourism events; Museum of mining 4. dritl.
