Results

- Over 100 student on the Plumbing and Electrical courses completed training module; 'Energy Efficiency in the Home and Fuel Poverty Awareness' training.

How has B2LC made a difference?

Training courses at SGS Berkeley Green College are highly technical but SWEA's intervention through the B2LC Action Plan introduced a holistic approach to interactions with vulnerable consumers.

- The future installers can identify those at risk of energy poverty
- Give meaningful and unbiased energy saving advice
- Signpost and refer to other agencies for further support.
