- Area: 34.160 km² (14.3 % of the country's area); population: 2.5 million inhabitants (13.1 % of the resident population of Romania); administration: 6 counties (Bihor, Satu-Mare, Maramureş, Cluj, Sălaj and Bistriţa-Năsăud); neighboring: Hungary and Ukraine.
- GDP/capita: 9.120 euro;
- GDP/capita in PPS: 61% compared to the EU average (PPS), the region is ranked less developed

• Cluj-Napoca is the regional innovation centre, one of the most important centres in the Eastern European IT industry, supported by the academic environment, the most performing university in Romania (Babes-Bolyai University) being

*located in the region* 

 Cluj-Napoca, Oradea or even counties such as Cluj, are national landmarks in terms of the development of digital public services

- The region ranks first at national level as of the **verdure spots areas** in municipalities
- From the **tourism** perspective, the region is distinguished primarily by health-spa-wellness tourism, cultural tourism, ecotourism, aso.







Through the **planning activity**, the North-West Regional Development Agency (RDA) contributes to the achievement of the three basic objectives of the regional development policy in Romania, stipulated in Law no. 315/2004 on regional development:

- reducing existing regional imbalances,
- correlating governmental sectoral policies at the regional level,
- stimulating inter-regional, domestic and international cross-border cooperation.

The planning process is materialized by the **Regional Development Plan (RDP)**, which is the strategic basis for substantiating projects initiated in the region and is a benchmark for both national authorities, county / local authorities, and for potential public or private investors.

To date, RDPs have been developed for the periods:

- pre-accession: 2000-2002, 2004-2006
- post-accession: 2007-2013, 2014-2020, 2021-2027


RDPs followed an exhaustive development process, involving partners from all regional counties, both in the design stages, as well as in the decision stages, and further on in the implementation ones.







- Creation of <u>partnership structures</u>, starting from the update of the Regional Planning Committee (CRP)
- Studying the <u>European and national context</u> (policies/strategies/plans/funds, etc.)
- Socio-economic analysis, taking into account statistical data for periods of 5-7 years
- <u>SWOT analysis</u> of the socio-economic development of the North-West Region



- <u>Consultations</u> with the regional sectoral working groups defined at regional level
  - Note: for 2021-2027 RDP, consultations were conducted by written procedures, under the Covid-19 pandemic
- Elaboration of the Regional Development Strategy,
- <u>Elaboration of the North-West RDP</u> document, incorporating the amendments received after public consultations
- Approval in the Regional Planning Committee

**Maramures county** has actively participated both in the Regional Planning Committee and in the Regional Sectoral Working Groups.

### Policy mix:


• Promoting the acquisition of new technologies, including energetic efficiency technologies, sustainable resource usage, eco-innovation usage and alignment to the principles of circular economy.
