

Policy instrument supporting CE

- Leuropean Regional Development Fund (ERDF)
- I Sustainable development is one of the key principles guiding the structural fund activities.
- In the programming period 2014-2020, a total of 25 per cent of the ERDF funding will be directed at low-carbon activities.
- I Eligibility criteria including e.g. promoting new green / sustainable business models.
- I Funding for the program 2014-2020 has been 6M€.
