- 1.3 million inhabitants (17.2 mln in NL)
- 1,554 km² land area (smallest of 12)



26 municipalities

2 major cities

- Utrecht: 350,000 inhabitants
- Amersfoort: 150,000 inhabitants

Aimed at western part of the Netherlands

- -Provinces: Southern+Nothern Holland, Flevoland, Utrecht
- -4 biggest cities: Amsterdam, Den Haag, Rotterdam, Utrecht

4 priorities:

- -1. Innovations by SME
- -2. Decarbonisation
- -3. Jobs creation, mobility and human capital
- -4. Social inclusion by improved business climate

Ongoing case 'Werkspoorkwartier' Utrecht

- Deprived industrial area 'Werkspoorkwartier'
 - New businesses started (m2) 'small'
 - Jobs created (FTE) 'social'



- Synergy with neighbouring larger industrial area 'Lage Weide'; supporting new businesses
- <u>Connected</u> effects to neighbouring residential areas; jobs creation CE, inclusion
- How to operationalise combined <u>technical</u>, <u>economic</u> and <u>social</u> views on circularity?
- How to cause and assess effects of circularity in local/industrial area?






CE Building and demolition projects in and around Utrecht










CE Projects, revitalising building buces Interreg Europe

Strenghts

- Many (small) initiatives
- Motivated front runners (also small)
- Support by inhabitants
- National theme
- Local public interest
- EU financial, research support: effects assessment

Weaknesses


- Lack of space and materials readily available
- For many organisations still relatively new theme
- Difficult to operationalise, finance
- Variable support by larger firms
- CE is not well defined nor embedded as an explicit goal in policy instruments


