

Location of GR 262

- The GR 262 is located in the province of Teruel. It has recently been incorporated into the Zaragoza municipality of Escatrón, where the Martín River has its mouth and connects with the GR 99 Ebro Nature Trail.
- The GR crosses the River Martín Cultural Park, which is also defined as the European Cultural Route (CARP)

IMPACT ON COMPANIES:

IMPACT ON NUMBER OF VISITS:

The Martín River Cultural Park has 4 ecometers that have given a total result of 16,000 steps counted among the 4 points in 2021.



Transferability

- Many of the natural tourist resources are not limited to a specific territory. Trails and rivers do not understand administrative limitations, whether they are provinces or countries.
- These tourist resources make sense for the visitor and become attractive when they become a source of sensations and challenges: Greater number of kilometers
- Diversity of landscapes
- Own entity: for example "accompany a river"
- Applicable to Greenways.
- The Bajo Martín region defends this same management system for the Green Way Valdezafán, which runs through 3 Teruel counties and 2 Catalan counties.
- The greatest point of support in the project has been the good track record of collaboration between the Cultural Park and the Public Administrations and all of us with the RRSS manager.
