






Possible incentives behind EMAS uptake trends









Policy







- Grants from the Circular economy programme to help implement EMAS
 <u>At least 3 organisations have utilized this</u>
 - In 2016/2017 Energy Sector Organization Act entered into force *EMAS*, ISO 14001 or ISO 50001 *certified organisation is exempt from energy audit requirement*.

There has been no effect

• Position that most if not all government agencies which operate within the area of the Ministry of Environment should be EMAS certified.

Limitations/benefits due to policy





- Lack of verifiers
- Lack of capacity of competent body
- The quality of implementation if the driver is benefits from legal acts

Affects credibility of EMAS

- Increased visibility
- Chance for the organisations to see the benefits

Limitations due to the scheme





- Lack of identifying the benefits of EMAS EMAS vs ISO
- Lack of EMAS knowledge in Estonian society
- Lack of visibility
