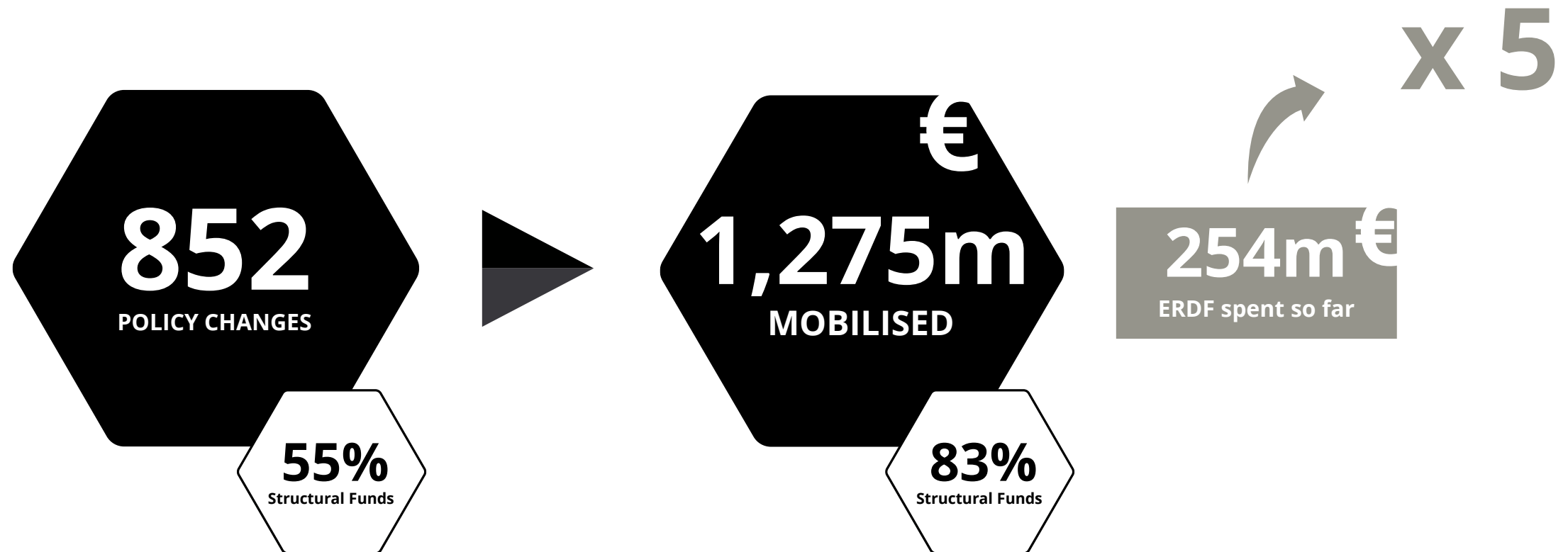

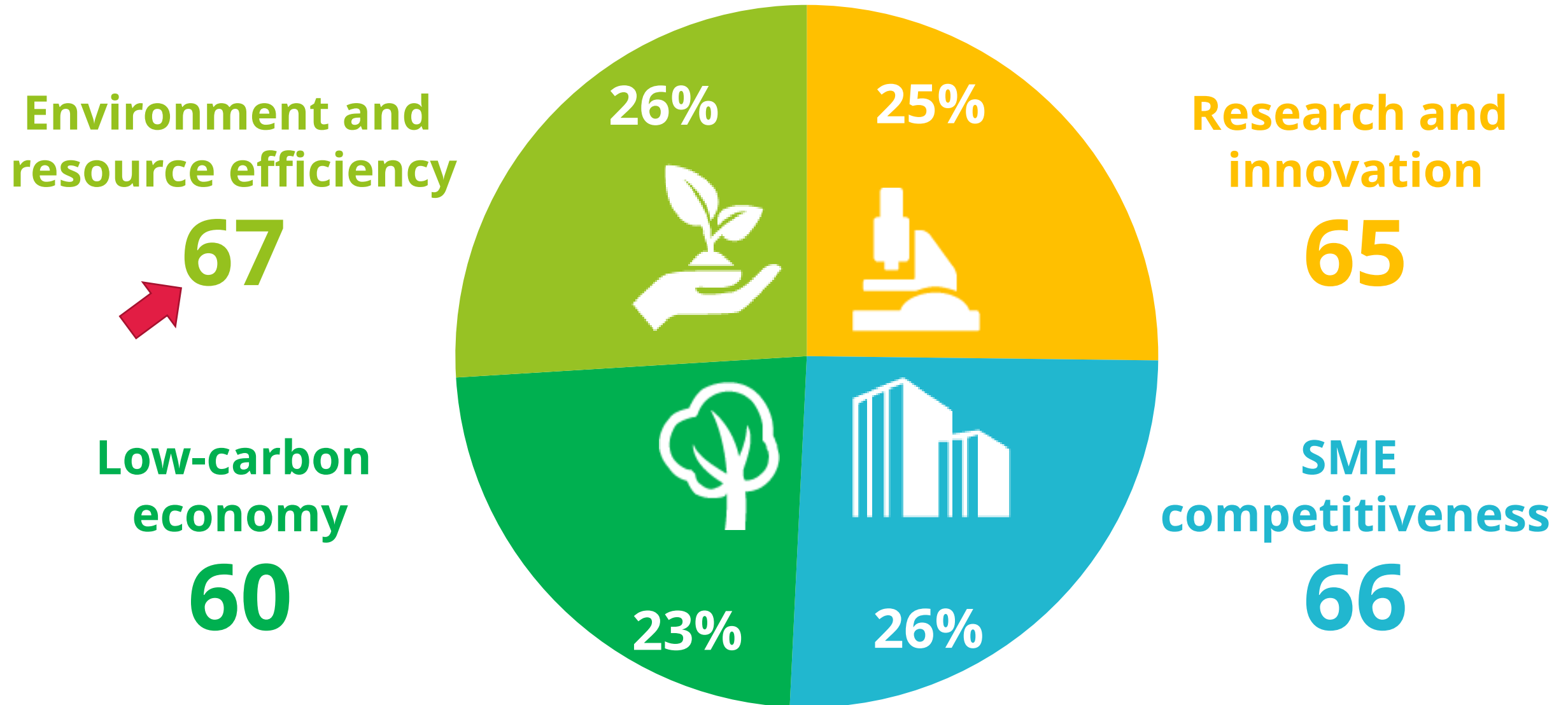

Strengths of WINPOL

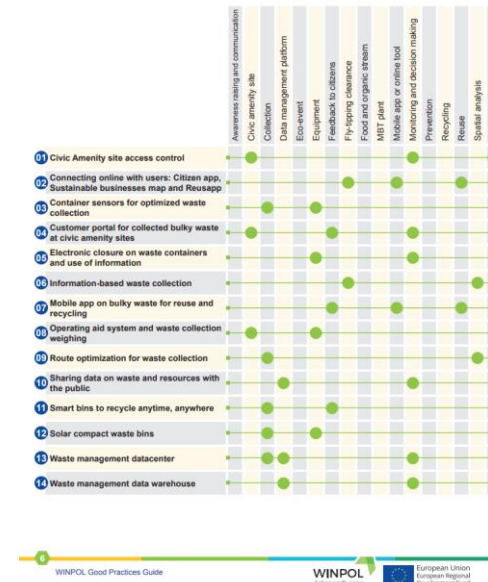

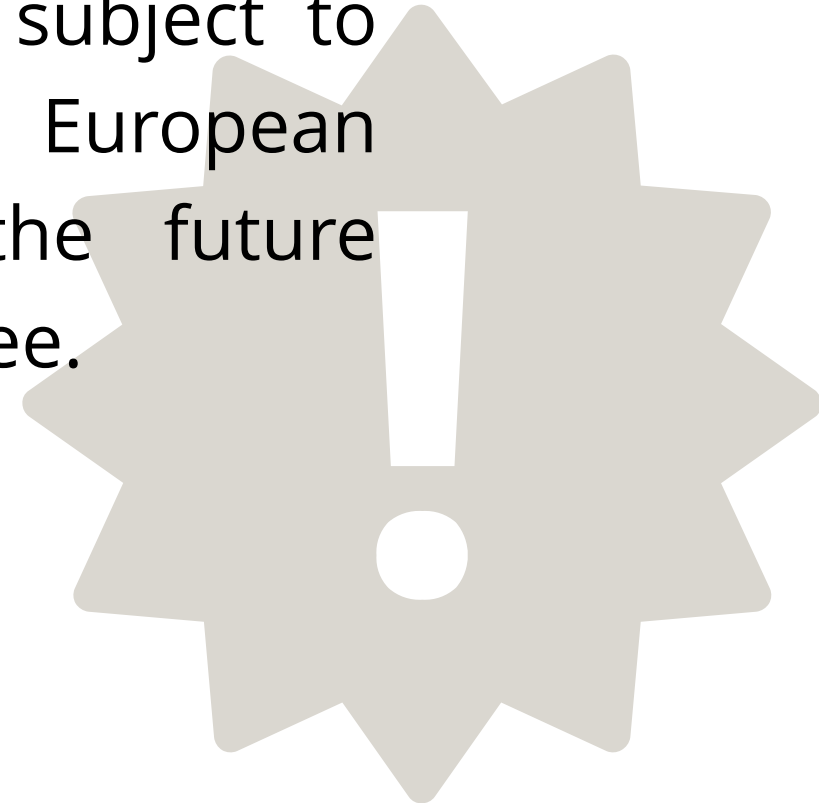

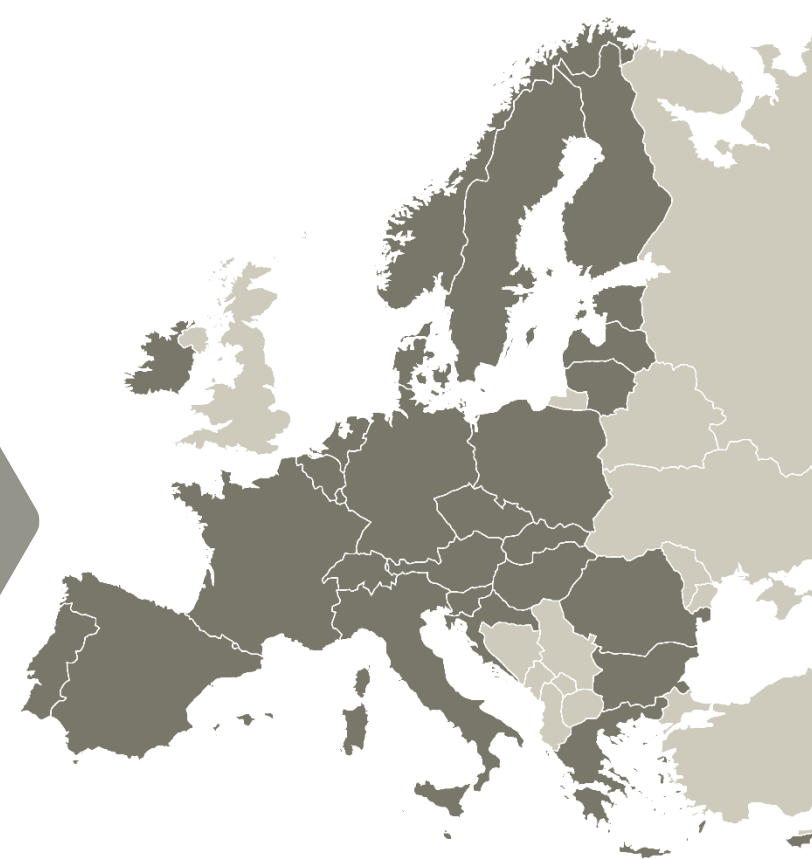

Through exchange of experience, innovative approaches and capacity building (in relation to the identification & transfer of good practices)

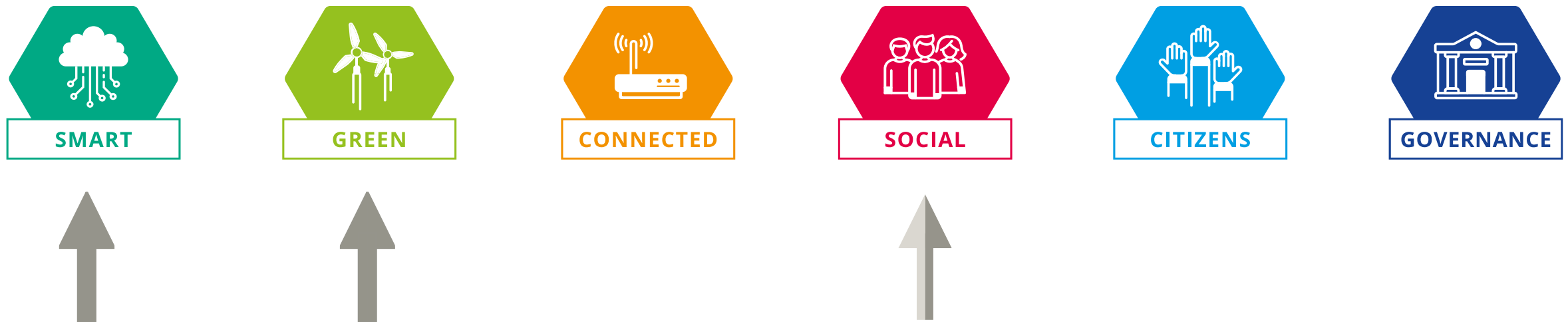
