# GOALS IN THE GOVERNMENT PROGRAMME 2020 - 2024

- Climate-neutral administration the public sector shows it
- Sustainable and innovation-friendly procurement is becoming the standard
  - Revise and update the **naBe action plan**
  - 100% ecolabelled electricity
  - Public fleet from 2022 alternatively operated as standard
  - Procurement of community catering and groceries: daily climate plate in public kitchens (vegetarian seasonal - regional - organic) - Target 100% regional procurement of food and 30% organic quota by 2025, 55% by 2030
  - Set up a comprehensive environmental management system (EMAS, ISO) in public administrations



# REALITY FOR SOME GOALS IN THE GOVERNMENT PROGRAMME 2020 – 2024

- Covid Pandemic has put focus on health rather than focus on "carbon neutral administration", it must first
  - In general: decrease in business trips; at least 2 days of home office
  - all ministries have to procure electricity with Ecolabel, there will also be a training for procurers in all ministries.
- full introduction and implementation of EMAS in public sector will not happen till 2024
- Revision and update of the naBe action plan -> next presentation
