	5/May Phase 22 - round 2	` ,	 Attendees were informed of all activities carried out in the project's frame since the last stakeholders' meeting on Phase 1, such as coordination meetings and dissemination actions. Tasks implemented related to the Action Plan in Mallorca in Phase 2 were introduced: Action 1 "Boosting cultural heritage linked to fishing communities in a regional coastal route": They were informed of the progress of the construction of a "gussi" carried out by the staff at the shipbuilders' workshop of Consell de Mallorca. Once this boat is finished, it will be used for educational activities promoting traditional rowing. The guide visits organized by the Cala Gamba Yacht Club at the maritime ecomuseum were presented.
