Results and findings



The BRIDGES project has followed five "lines" of dissemination:

- social media: OK, but results, we need to discuss
- partners' web sites: OK, but....

— presentation in events: the added value is in the attendees (thematic targeted group) and the interaction with them. Our assessment is that this is a very positive option. We are thinking of some ways to make the presentation more alive, more effective.

— PLP meetings: this is one of the best options, but of course it depends on the themes and criteria of the Policy Learning Platform events.

— articles / presentations to scientific events: to our experience, this is one of the very positive options, it allows insights and paths the way for next steps.

One more type of dissemination was identified, but not tested as much as we would like: we have been trying to join hands with the Joint Research Centre initiatives and S3 partnerships.
