


### Interregional cooperation **projects** 2014 – 2020


#### Interreg Europe objective

Through exchange of experience, innovative approaches and capacity building (in relation to the identification & transfer of good practices)


- Primarily dedicated to **policymakers**

1 cross-cutting priority on capacity building **—** six topics




**Concentration** principle (80%)





#### What is **new**?


Only one single priority: capacity building




Focus on **Structural Funds** lightened: only 1 policy instrument



More flexibility on **pilot actions**: possible from the start of the project



Fixed duration of **4 years**: 3 years in core phase and 1 year in the follow up phase



**Results** to be achieved by end of core phase! **No action plan** (except for regions that did not achieve any policy improvement within 3 years)
