1.	Welcome, opening and approval of the agenda
	Chair welcomed all MC members.
	Decision: the agenda (Annex 02) was approved without objections.
2.	Presentation of the new MC members
	The new participant from <b>IT</b> introduced himself.
3.	Presentation of S3Chem project
	The Ministry of Economy, Science and Digitalisation of Saxony-Anhalt (DE), lead partner of the S3Chem project, presented the project as well as its main achievements ( <b>Annex 03</b> ).
4.	Update on programme developments
	JS presented the latest developments in terms of JS human resources (Annex 04). The MC did not have any comments.
	<b>JS</b> reminded that the Chair recently signed and sent a letter on negative interest to the <b>EC</b> . The objective of this letter is that DG Regio declares negative interest expenditure as eligible for the TA budget of the programme.
	<b>EC</b> confirmed that the letter arrived and declared that several other programmes sent similar letters. The letter is currently reviewed by the <b>EC</b> legal service, which is working on a reply.
5.	Update on Communication activities (2020 + 2021 plan)
	<b>JS</b> presented the update in communication activities from September to December 2020 and an overview of the plans for communication activities in 2021 ( <b>Annex 05</b> ).
6.	Policy Learning Platform update
	JS updated the MC on the Platform activities and the current results (Annex 06).



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7.	Projects' monitoring
	<b>JS</b> updated the MC on various issues related to project monitoring such as changes in running projects, the outcome of the recent mid-term review update, and the pilot actions state of play and projects achievements ( <b>Annex 07</b> ).
8.	Update on finances
	<ul> <li>In the first part, JS updated the MC about matters (see Annex 08.1) related to:</li> <li>Management and Control System Description (MCSD), which was updated following system audit findings and new procedures and resubmitted to the audit authority</li> <li>Arachne results 2019-2020, where no high risk was detected;</li> <li>Audit of operations' results 2020, where the projected error rate was 0.1% (i.e. far below the 2% threshold),</li> <li>Audit of accounts 2019/2020.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>In the second part, the JS updated the MC about matters (see Annex 08.2) related to:</li> <li>the programme spending target (no decommitment risk for 2020 nor 2021)</li> <li>the ERDF commitment rate (the commitment rate is below 100% (after the MC had committed 105% in 2019)</li> <li>the ERDF spending rate forecast based on closed project (the programme might be underspending by ca. 20MEUR by the time all projects are closed)</li> <li>the ERDF spending rate forecast, which will be refined once more projects are closed and more budget reviews have been carried out in the coming six months.</li> </ul>
	An updated note on the programme spending with information related to Norwegian funding is available as <b>Annex 08.3</b> .
9.	COVID crisis & underspending: possible programme strategy
	<b>JS</b> presented to the MC the programme strategy for COVID-19 crisis and underspending (see <b>Annex 09</b> ) and namely the launch of a restricted call (context, beneficiaries, practical aspects, feedback from projects).
	Following the PS' positive feedback on the proposal, the <b>JS</b> confirmed that a written procedure will be prepared beginning 2021 to decide on the restricted call.
