Key lessons

- Handy app – both for planners and citizens
- Useful insight for the project, pupils and coming projects
- Engaging activity – especially for the youngest pupils
- Teachers involvement is important
- 55 pupils = 55 families = 150 citizens

- More benches
- Improved bicycle lanes in the area
- Heart zone around schools
