












The Region is based at the city of **Thessaloniki** and is divided into seven (7) regional units.





The region accounted for 13.5% of the national GDP, while in terms of GDP per capita was positioned 9th among the 13 Greek regions and below the EU27 average (57%).



■ The Region of Central Macedonia is staffed by a total of approx. 2,000 employees.



Directly subject to the Governor of the Region is the Managing Authority of the Region of Central Macedonia

(Regional Operational Program 2014-2020)
(Regional Operational Program 2021-2027)

Co-Responsible entity for drafting and implementing the Regional Innovation Strategy (RIS3)

The Metropolitan Unit of Thessaloniki of RCM, called as urban authority, is assigned as intermediate body for the SUD of Thessaloniki plan with specific responsibilities.



Sustainable Mobility in RCM

Sustainable Mobility is integrated in the Regional Operation Programme (ROP) under the Priority Axes:

- 4e Promotion of low-carbon strategies for all types of regions, particularly for urban areas, including the promotion of sustainable multimodal urban mobility and mitigation measures.
- ➤ 6e Actions to improve the urban environment, regenerate cities, rejuvenation and disinfection of degraded areas (Including areas to be reconstructed), reduction of air pollution, and promoting measures to reduce noise.

Sustainable Mobility in RCM

The Strategic Plan of Sustainable Urban Development of Thessaloniki for smart, sustainable and inclusive growth is a paradigm of metropolitan planning which entails the collaboration of local citizens, civil society, industry and various levels of government...

The specific project aims to respond to all **Challenges**, **Capabilities**, **Weaknesses** and **Perspectives** through **4 Strategic Axes**

Thessaloniki, competitive and innovative - 15.756.939 €

to support entrepreneurship and to attract new activities to rebrand the city as a tourist destination based on cultural heritage

Thessaloniki, cohesive - 12.805.001€

to relieve the disadvantaged people from the deep economic recession

Thessaloniki, green and resilient - 50.215.000 €

to involve interventions such as ecosystem approached in the urban environment,

to enhance green areas and free spaces

to promote the sustainable urban mobility (almost 9%)

Thessaloniki, effective - 6.050.000 €

to ensure the efficiency of the administration

to modernize the organization of local operations,

to promote the integrated urban governance and metropolitan synergies.





Sustainable Mobility in RCM

More specifically the distribution of funding for the Specific Objective the **3.3** sustainable urban mobility is analyzed in three fields of Interventions:

- **3.3.1** Actions for multimodal urban transport, involving the promotion of electric buses and buses of alternative fuels, the development of bike sharing systems and the creation of park and ride spaces (budget: 2.565.000€)
- 3.3.2 Creation of bike lanes (budget: 1.000.000€)
- 3.3.3 Development of Intelligent Transport Systems (ITS) (budget: 2.850.000€)
- ✓ also a dedicated *budget of 800.000*€ is foreseen for the development of interoperable information systems for the Municipalities, (field of Intervention *4.1.1.* to promote interoperable information systems for the Municipalities and the Region)
- ✓ while a budget of 1.000.000€ is foreseen for the strengthening of the monitoring through observatories of urban challenges (field of Intervention 4.2.2. to strengthen monitoring networks and urban challenges observatories)
