The ESPON 2030 Programme

ESP N provides territorial evidence to support stakeholders at all levels in achieving green transition to climate-neutral economies while ensuring at the same time just living conditions for all people in all places

What is the mission of ESPON in 2021-2027?

- In the 2021-2027 period, ESPON's mission is to provide territorial evidence to support stakeholders at all levels in achieving green transition to climate-neutral economies, while ensuring at the same time just living conditions for all people in all places.
- ESPON aims to reinforce the quality and effectiveness of policies at all levels EU, macroregional, cross-border and national (regional/local) - in the member countries and partner states of the ESPON 2030 Programme.
- To accomplish that, ESPON will produce new territorial evidence and transfer the resulting knowledge to stakeholders at all levels.
- To make the knowledge 'actionable', ESPON needs to ensure that stakeholders understand the territorial evidence and can use it in their policy processes.




- Information pack for stakeholders soon available
